Reference to your letter dated 30.06.2022 regarding the above cited subject matter, it is to inform you that the case was examined as per DERC Regulations and it was observed that the bills were being raised in two part tariff i.e. fixed charges and units consumption charges. The fixed charges (in KVA) are driven on the basis of use type of load in the premises and depends on power factor recorded by the meter for conversion from KW to KVA and the unit consumption are being charged on KVAH recorded by the energy meter as per DERC Tariff Order.

New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) had generated the electricity bills in the month of February 2022 wherein the sundry amount was shown in sundry/ CCTV box of electricity bill which was not related with the CCTV installation charges but recovery on account of short billing w.e.f. 01.04.2018 to June/July/August, 2020 (till the date of implementation of KVAH pattern in the respective bills) on Non-Domestic connections (upto 10 KW load) due to Conversion of billing concept from KWH (Active Energy) to KVAH (Apparent Energy) as per DERC Tariff Order issued in 28.03.2018. The actual cause of charge was mentioned/ depicted in the form of red colour text message in the electricity bill and also put on NDMC website as well as in print media.

Further, NDMC has also implemented the Special Subsidy Scheme of GNCTD to the Lawyer's Chambers in the Court Premises from the billing cycle February 2022 onward and reversed back the sundry amount which was reflected in the electricity bill cycle February 2022. The reversed sundry amount has been adjusted after making the necessary calculations of arrears from 2017-18 onward in respect of individual consumers. The necessary adjustment of subsidy arrear as announced by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi shall be reflected in the billing cycle of July 2022 w.e.f. 01.10.2017 (from the date of implementation - bill cycle November 2017 to 31.12.2022 - bill cycle January 2022).
